Overview

The IRCA Registered EMS auditor conversion course provides students with the knowledge and skills required to assess the conformance of an organisation's Environmental Systems with ISO 14001 be it at an internal level, supplier assessment or independent 3rd Party level. Any Environmental Management System requires an effective audit by a competent Environmental Management Systems auditor, which requires a comprehensive understanding of environmental aspects and impacts and improvement processes.

The course is aimed primarily at people who have audit experience, have preferably completed a lead audit course and now wish to add the ability to audit Environmental Management Systems to their overall audit capability.

Upon successful completion, delegates receive an IRCA Certified Certificate stating they have "Successfully Completed the ISO 14001:2004 EMS Auditor Conversion Programme (IRCA/2007).
